



## Guidelines for Animals at the NW Pet Fair

These guidelines are in place for the safety of your animals and for the safety of the animals brought in from the public. This is a unique event where hundreds of pets will be in the same Hall.

- 🐾 You may bring your pet with you to the NW Pet Fair!
- 🐾 Pets need to be kenneled, in an enclosed or fenced area, or kept on a leash at all times.
- 🐾 Please pick up after your pet.
- 🐾 Dogs must be licensed and current on Parvo and Rabies vaccinations.
- 🐾 Do not bring female dogs in heat.
- 🐾 No dogs under 6 months, please.
- 🐾 All Animals must have all age appropriate vaccinations.
- 🐾 Guests must sanitize hands before and after petting animals.
- 🐾 Do not bring animals with bite history.
- 🐾 Cats need to be in safe enclosures with 3' barrier from contact with dogs.
- 🐾 Cats and Kittens must go home in fully enclosed carrier (no leash and harness), even if client says they wish otherwise.
- 🐾 Do not bring kittens or cats showing signs of upper respiratory infection.
- 🐾 Neither vendors nor others may sell pets of any kind on or near the event grounds.
- 🐾 Please use good judgment regarding the temperament of your pet so that this event will be safe and enjoyable for everyone.

### Pet Messes:

There will be a lot of animals on the show floor and accidents will happen. Please be prepared for this and bring something to clean up after your pet. Biokleen Pet Mess Stations will be placed throughout the exhibit hall.

We will have volunteers at the show and if there is a mess in the aisle, please let the one of the *Biokleeners* or Show Management Staff know so we can have a quick clean up.

### Pet Relief:

The Biokleen Pet Relief Areas will be clearly marked on the show floorplan and signage. Please take your pets there or outside to use the restroom.
