Guidelines for Animals

These guidelines are in place for the safety of all animals attending the NW Pet Fair. This is a unique event where hundreds of pets will be in the same Hall.

- 🐾 You may bring your pet with you to the NW Pet Fair.
- 🐾 Animals must be kenneled, in an enclosed or fenced area, or kept on a leash at all times.
- 🐾 Please pick up after your animal.
- 🐾 Animals must be licensed and current on all age appropriate vaccinations.
- 🐾 Do not bring female animals that are in heat.
- 🐾 Guests must sanitize hands before and after petting animals.
- 🐾 Do not bring animals with bite history.
- 🐾 Cats need to be in safe enclosures with a 3' barrier from contact with dogs.
- 🐾 Cats and kittens must go home in a fully enclosed carrier (no leash and harness), no exceptions!
- 🐾 Do not bring cats or kittens showing signs of upper respiratory infection.
- 🐾 No animals of any kind may be sold on, or near, the event grounds.

Pet Messes:

There will be many animals on the show floor. Accidents will happen. Please be prepared and bring something to clean up after your pet. Pet Mess Stations will be placed throughout the exhibit hall. We will have volunteers at the show responsible for cleaning up messes. If there is a mess in the aisle, please let Show Management know immediately, so that we can act quickly.

Pet Relief:

The Pet Relief Areas will be clearly marked on the show floorplan and signage. Please take your pets to these areas or outside to use the restroom.
